The project at hand includes more than \$28 million in federal grants, in addition to \$35 million in low-interest loans to install fiber optic networks in Plainview, Littlefield, Levelland, Brownfield, Lamesa and Slaton, as well as several smaller communities between those hubs. A second network, PRIDE 2, in the Wichita Falls area began construction in October, and a PRIDE 3 is in the planning phase in southern Louisiana.

We were successful through negotiation presentations over the first quarter 2011 to contractually dedicate resources for the project of approximately \$6million.
