



Auga Caliente Solar, NextLight Solar Farm

Pauley Construction, part of the Quanta Renewable Energy Services solar arm, participated in our first solar farm builds in the summer of 2010. We were awarded the early construction phase of a 120Mw Solar Farm in Dateland Arizona. This early stage was in part to prepare the APS switch yard sub base as well as all on site roads, culverts, bridge, service roads to the Maintenance Storage Facility and all offsite improvements.

Pauley Construction being an Arizona Based Company capitalized on our strengths of relationships and resources to pull together in effort to stimulate the local economy. Our presence in Yuma of more than 19 years gave us the competitive edge with local municipalities and regulatory agencies to facilitate the project in such a manner that we beat the project due date by almost 30%.



The project area was a minimal 150 acres to include our development of a water well, holding pond and extensive efforts to pull from the location and harvest local road base and material used for the under base of the APS 20 acre Switch Yard.



With the ADEQ cracking down on dust control we partnered with local specialists in dust mitigation and soil stabilization to maintain and meet the requirements of dust control.
